IMPORTANT - NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

First of all, we would like to thank you for your interest in our interior agility trial. We hope that you will appreciate the Stade Leclerc as much as we do. As you probably already know, it is the up most importance that we all cooperate in keeping this site clean, by picking up after ourselves and of course our dogs, in all indoor and outdoor areas used by competitors and their dogs.

This trial is being held under AAC rules. Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AAC rules and regulations. All obstacles will conform to AAC specifications. A breakable tire and electronic timer will be used in Ring 2. This trial is open to all dogs over 18 months of age, including purebred and mixed breeds, who have an AAC ID number (excluding bitches in season).. The waiver found at the bottom of this form MUST be signed in order to be entered. The Organizing committee, Club Les Mordus de concours d'Agilité, may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog.

All dogs must remain on leash at all times, except in the warm-up area or when competing in the ring. Every competitor participating in this event does so at their own risk and are solely responsibility of their dogs actions. Dogs exhibiting signs of nuisance or aggression, may at the discretion of the Organizing committee, be asked to leave the premises without being reimbursed.

Entry fees for all official classes with be \$17,00 per class. No post-dated cheques dated after the closing date will be accepted. No refunds, cancellation or changes accepted after the closing date. A refund will be issued for bitches coming into season or dogs injured, providing that the trial secretary is advised within 24 hours before the start of the trial. Any refunds issued after the closing date will be done so minus an administrative fee.

Confirmations letters and order of classes will be sent out electronically via email after the closing date, unless you have specifically requested otherwise. Competitors will have until March 25 to advise the trial secretary of any changes due to new titles obtained beforehand. Dogs who have earned an AAC title on the 1st and 2nd day of the trial, may advance to a higher level the next day, provided that the secretary is notified in writing before the end of the day.

This trial will be held indoors in a soccer complex on Astro Turf. All competitors accompanied by their dogs must use the door situated on the right side of the building (right when you are facing the building). The locker rooms normally used by soccer teams on the 1st floor and a few other rooms on the 2nd floor will be available for crating and personal belongings. There is very limited space available on the synthetic surface close to the rings. Only cages with mats placed underneath will be tolerated on this surface. Also no food or beverages, other than water, will be allowed when on this surface. Since the crating area is limited, and if possible, we ask that competitors only be accompanied with dogs competing in the trial. Competitors, however, may set up their chairs near the agility rings or use the second floor bleachers. A warm-up area will be available for competitors and their dogs.

Even though a restaurant offering breakfast, lunch and supper can be found on the second floor and will be open Saturday and Sunday from 7 h 30 to 20hr, there is no restriction against bringing food into the Stade. However, no food or beverages are allowed on the soccer field itself.

ROSETTES AND RIBBONS

- ❖ Qualifying score rosettes or ribbons (per choice).
- ❖ Rosette to 1st place in Regular 10", 16", 22" & 26" classes.
- ❖ Rosettes or ribbons to 2nd to 4th places in Regular 10", 16", 22" & 26" classes.

- ❖ Rosette to 1st place in Special and Veteran 6", 10", 16" and 22" classes.
- ❖ Rosettes or ribbons to 2nd to 4th places in Special and Veteran 6", 10", 16" & 22" classes.
- ❖ A rosette will be awarded for all Titles completed.

Results should be available approx. 15 min. after each class.

Ribbons will be self-service. However, there will a sheet to indicate if a title has been obtained and an official presentation will be done at the end of each day to award titles.

LODGING

The Campus Notre Dame de Foy, where the Stade Leclerc is situated, offers university type lodgings to our competitors and dogs are welcome. The majority of the rooms do not have a TV or radio. Only a large parking lot separates the two buildings. The price of the rooms varies depending on services offered.

DIRECTIONS

Coming from Rte. 20 :

Starting from Pierre- Laporte bridge, take Duplessis North ((540 N.) Immediately after going down the hill, keep to your right and take exit 3 – Charest West (40). While in the exit, keep left. After driving about 3km on Rte 40, take the exit 302 – Jean Gauvin. Keep right on Jules Vernes Ave. At the stop keep right again on Jean Gauvin and go beneath the underpass. At the 1st light, turn right onto chemin l'Hétrière. Drive approx. 3km on this road. At the intersection keep right and turn onto chemin de la Butte. At the next light, turn left and you will be on Suzanne-Lamy which is on the Campus Notre Dame site. If you are staying at the Congress Centre, it will be immediately on your right. The Stade Leclerc is situated behind this building. At the stop, turn right and Marius-Barbeau will be on your right.

Coming from Rte 40 E (Montréal) :

From Rte 40, take exit 295 (route de Fassambault). Turn right on de Fassambault. Turn left on Rte 138. Not long after, take route Tessier on your right. Route Tessier will become chemin de la Butte. After approx. 3 km., at the light, turn right onto Suzanne-Lamy which is on the Campus Notre Dame site. If you are staying at the Congress Centre, it will be immediately on your right. The Stade Leclerc is situated behind this building. At the stop, turn right and Marius-Barbeau will be on your right
